## Household Chemicals:

Home/garden/garage chemicals, used motor oil & filters, yard & garden chemicals, antifreeze, gasoline, stain, oil-based paint, varnish, household & car batteries, cleaners, paint thinner, unwanted pills and other medications, medical needles/sharps, mercury items, compact fluorescent light bulbs & tubes, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, small 1-lb propane cylinders, adhesives, driveway sealer & more.

**NOT ACCEPTED:** latex paint, gas grill size propane tanks, ammo, and fireworks. See recycling & disposal options on the website.

## Electronic Waste (fees apply on certain items):

Unwanted electronic equipment that has a cord or is battery operated such as small & large appliances, computers, computer monitors (**\$10/monitor fee**), televisions (**\$20/TV fee**), printers, phones, window air conditioners, DVD/VCR players, power tools, dehumidifiers, cameras, etc. Recycled by:
