### BURNING PERMIT

IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT TO:

1. Make sure that the material to be burned is at least 50' from any structure or other combustible material.
2. Assure that applicable & necessary fire extinguishing equipment is readily available at the site as determined by the Fire Chief or designee.
3. Guarantee that the fire is constantly attended by a person that is knowledgeable in the extinguishing equipment that is available and that the fire is extinguished before leaving the site.
4. Ensure that there is no illegal material in the burn pile. Illegal material includes but is not limited to; grass clippings, leaves, trash / rubbish, building / construction materials, automotive parts (including tires), furniture, appliances, etc...
5. Verify that wind speed and direction will not be a hazard or nuisance to neighboring properties.

Be it further noted that the applicant:

1. Shall be guilty of a Civil Infraction by leaving the fire unattended.
2. Shall be responsible for any damages that result from the fire getting out of control and any damage to other property.

The Fire Chief or Designee retains the right to revoke this permit or require the fire to be extinguished when in his/her judgment the fire might constitute a hazard because of high winds or other conditions.
