TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF BRIDGMAN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A PRIMARY ELECTION will be held in the City of Bridgman on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 2, 2022** at City Hall, 9765 Maple St., Bridgman, MI 49106. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Primary is for the purpose of nominating the representatives for the Republican Party, Democratic Party to the following partisan offices: Governor, U.S. Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, County Commissioner, Delegate to County Convention and such other partisan offices that may by law be required to be nominated at the primary.

The following Proposals will be voted on:

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the **Bridgman Library** to continue to levy its authorized millage rate that will expire with the 2022 tax levy. Not to exceed 0.9685 mills (\$0.97 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation)

PUBLIC RECREATION AND PLAYGROUNDS MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the **Bridgman Public Schools** to continue to levy its authorized millage rate that will expire with the 2022 tax levy. Not to exceed 0.5 mills (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for 10 years.

SINKING FUN MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the **Bridgman Public Schools** to continue to levy its authorized millage rate that will expire with the 2023 tax levy. Not to exceed 0.5 mills (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for 10 years.

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the City Clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
